Addend + Addend = Sum

Array: an arrangement of objects, pictures, or numbers in columns and rows is called an array. Arrays are useful representations of multiplication concepts.

Difference: the result of subtracting a number from another.

Fact Fluency: the ability to recall the answer to a basic fact automatically and accurately without resorting to inefficient means, such as counting.

Factor x Factor = Product

Regrouping: a term used to describe the process of changing groups of ones into tens to make adding and subtracting easier. (Formerly known as carrying/ borrowing)

Related Facts: facts that show the inverse relationship between addition/ subtraction and multiplication/ division. (also known as “fact families”)

Ten Frame: a visual tool to help “see” numbers.
